Below is the mode of conduct which may be followed for providing the required counselling help to the students.


- Students can approach faculty members for counselling help
- Faculty members handling courses/ Class Advisors/Mentors may identify the requirement of counselling for any student based on their observations
- The faculty member shall then need to inform the coordinator about their observations or send the students to the coordinators (listed below)
- Coordinators will further interact with the student and on need basis, arrange for a meeting of the student and the counsellor on campus.

Listed below are some of the student behavioural parameters that may be monitored by Faculty members/ mentors or Class Advisor and communicated to the counselling coordinators.

- Conduct and interaction in the class
- Consistent/Unexpected bad performance in continuous assessment, internal assessment tests
- Irregularity in Class Attendance
- Lack of attention
