The event featured two distinguished speakers:


1.Dr. P. Supraja, who joined the session virtually (Google meet link: https://meet.google.com/tqo-ncmv-dnb), and

- 3. Recognizing that genuine happiness stems from harmonious relationships and purposeful living.


Her thought-provoking insights left a lasting impression on the audience, encouraging them to reflect on their current practices and strive for a more values-driven approach to life.
