
# WORKSHOPS/SEMINARS



- The meeting provided a platform for open communication between parents and faculty regarding the academic progress, attendance and overall development of students.




# ROLE AT MADRAS ENGINEER GROUP AND CENTRE




#### SYNAPSE OFF-STAGE EVENTS
