- The law school is to invite elective offerings from all other relevant schools of DSU.
 Doing so will allow the program to offer a wide basket of interdisciplinary courses.
- The program may be designed such that, students can choose two majors, and then some general liberal studies elective papers. This will ensure that the requirement for majors and directive education components of the CBCS are also met.
- Papers to be invited from the School of Arts, Design, and Humanities: Mass Communication and Journalism, the School of Arts, Design, and Humanities: Design, the School of Medicine: Public Health, the School of Basic and Applied Sciences, and the School of Engineering.
- Given that the law school is looking to have a keen focus on law and technology, it is
 essential that there is a component of Science and Technology studies as part of the
 curriculum.
- It must be remembered that the program is still an undergraduate program, therefore, a
 few foundational subjects must be mandated.
- The 5-year programs will mandate components of Science and Technology Studies and two papers of Law and Society studies where the foundations of social science are covered.
- Students to two foreign languages as part of the program.

Discussions on BBA.LLB with Interdisciplinary Management Studies

- Interdisciplinary Management Papers to be invited from the School of Commerce and Management, the School of Medicine: Public Health, School of Basic and Applied Sciences, and the School of Engineering.
- The program may be designed such that, students can choose two majors, and then
 some general interdisciplinary management studies elective papers. This will ensure
 that the requirement for majors and directive education components of the CBCS are
 also met.
- BBA.LLB (hons) program to also include mandatory modules on STS and Law and Society Studies that covers the foundations of social science.

- BBA.LLB (hons) program to include electives that closely work with the start-up studio operation in DSU and focus on key areas like entrepreneurship.
- Students to two foreign languages as part of the program.

- Students will have to take 3 interdisciplinary law electives, and 3 law and tech electives, and one clinical paper from the Start up Studio.
