The Course on 'Gender Sensitization: Society, Culture and Change' aims to address the prevailing notions of gender issues in the society and ways to address the same. It also aims to provide ways to bring about changes in the society by addressing values like equality and equity. Culture, Society and State constructed certain norms, customs, and stereotypes to look into women, men and their issues. Due to patriarchal social construction, women are not treated on par with men. Women face challenges to realize their rights, aspirations, and potentials. It is important to deconstruct the prevailing patriarchal notions about women, men, and other sexualities. Family, Society and State also construct and reinforce roles and responsibilities for men and women. The existing power relations between men and women play an important role in controlling and dominating women. The disciplines of Women's and Gender Studies and Gender and Development Studies have theoretically addressed these issues. Relationship between men and women, their roles and responsibilities and myths related to other sexualities need to be deconstructed. The Course on "Gender Sensitization: Society, Culture and Change" specifically aims to build understanding of women's status in our society and identifying ways to address the same. It requires a new understanding of construction of gender to reconstruct 'gender just society'.

The incident of Nirbhaya in the Capital of the Nation not only exhibits how such treatment is basically an anathema to the concept of gender justice but also exposes the barbaric mindset annihilating the values of basic civilization. The days of yore when women were treated as fragile, feeble, dependent, and subordinate to men, should be a matter of history. The course is aimed at acquainting the participants with the concept of gender justice. From the arena of Constitutional guarantees to criminal law to laws ensuring safety at the workplace, specifically sexual harassment, the course will focus on an understanding the laws, its procedural intricacies and judicial decisions aimed at strengthening the position of women in society.

Project Summary :

Alzheimer's disease is one of the diseases under the category of neurodegeneration. This disease is gradually increasing its prevalence in Asian countries and, due to the need to develop novel anti-Alzheimer's drugs. In the past few decades, no new anti-Alzheimer's drug has been successfully developed. Currently, less than a handful of drugs are available, like Donepezil, Galantamine, Rivastigmine, and Memantine. All these drugs have only symptomatic activity and not therapeutic activity. New concept of immunotherapy has also been adopted, and a few monoclonal antibodies and vaccines against beta-amyloid and tau proteins are developed and are under trial. Certain specialists suggest taking a new and different approach to amelioration of Alzheimer's. With this information, we plan to develop novel TrkB agonists against Alzheimer's disease. TrkB receptors are activated by neurotrophins, which are reported for cell differentiation, cell growth, proliferation, cell repair, and cellular plasticity. TrkB shows its activity by three different cellular pathways namely: Ras/MAPK/ERK, PI3K/Akt, and CaMKII/DAG pathways. All these pathways are responsible for cell growth and differentiation which, improves the condition of Alzheimer's disease. With this concept, we plan to develop novel TrkB agonists using 7,8-DHF as a parent molecule. 7,8-DHF is a naturally occurring molecule with potent binding and TrkB agonist activity. Therefore we hypothesize targeting and activation of TrkB with the newly developed 7,8-DHF derivative molecule, leading to the successful relief of Alzheimer's disease. We have developed a few derivatives as TrkB agonists via computational docking studies, and they have shown positive results. The leads will be evaluated in vitro and in vivo, which has not been explored yet. Our study plan includes 1. Drug design and optimization of TrkB agonist, 2. Synthesis of top molecules and drug evaluation, 3. Evaluation of Pharmacokinetics and signaling, 4. In vitro cell line studies of lead molecules using Alzheimer's specific cell lines, 5. In vivo examination of lead molecules in animal models followed by biochemical and histological evaluation. Hypothetical result: The developed novel TrkB agonist molecule relieves one of the pathology in pathogenesis and can increase the life of Alzheimer's patients and their quality of life. This novel compound can also be used for other neurodegenerative diseases.

Objectives:

- Computational design and lead optimization of TrkB agonists.
- Chemical synthesis of designed TrkB agonists by green chemistry approach.
- In vitro quantitative cell-based assays to determine anti-Alzheimer's properties of TrkB agonists, alone or in combination with standard cholinergic ADs, on IPSCs and Htt-25KshD cells.
- Pharmacokinetic studies including western blotting.
- In vivo pharmacological screening of hit molecules against Scopolamine, Maximum chloride-induced Alzheimer's, and chemical-induced Alzheimer's disease in Zebrafish.
- Behavioral, Biochemical, and Histopathological evaluation of novel TrkB agonist against Alzheimer's disease.

Expected Output and Outcome of the project:

Alzheimer's disease is one of the largest occurring neurodegenerative diseases. Previously it was seen that this disease did not have a significant incidence in the Indian sub-continent but, recent studies show that over 10 percent of the risk group have acquired the disease. This gives us the agenda to develop novel therapies against this disease and also the fact that no new significant drug was developed in the past 20 years, gives a reason to step into drug development through different approaches for this disease. In our study, we plan to develop, synthesize, and evaluate the activity of TrkB agonists. TrkB is a significant neuronal growth factor receptor responsible for cell proliferation, differentiation, and repair. Clinical studies on TrkB agonists is not carried out. This study will be extremely helpful in the therapy of Alzheimer's disease, which is an increasing growth. Various neurodegenerative disorders like Parkinsonism, Multiple sclerosis, and ALS (amyotrophic lateral sclerosis), which have similar disease progression can be also be dealt with by utilizing the outcome of this study. This study will benefit the geriatric population of our country and improve the standard of living.

This study also has the mentorship of Dr. N.M. Raghavendra, a Professor, has vast knowledge of drug development and synthesis processes. Under the mentorship of this vast knowledgeable person, our project will proceed smoothly.

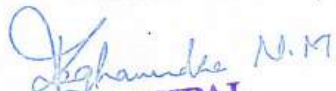
2. Specific facilities provided for women in terms of:

7.1.1 Measures initiated by the Institution for the promotion of gender equity during the last five years.

Department of CST in line with DSU actively promotes gender equity as a means to achieve gender equality - equity being the means to the end, equality with respect to gender, in all its HR policies as well as with respect to the entire provisions envisaged to the student body. University ensures people what they need - equity, as well as provide everyone the same things - equality. Women empowerment is obvious in all aspects of curricula and academic processes, and through co and extracurricular activities, institutional events like workshops, seminars and guest lectures. A framework of systematized and standardized procedures is adopted and monitored ensuring adherence to the gender equity and women empowerment policies. DSU prescribes and offers several regular academic courses sensitizing the students about gender equity and empowerment. These courses attempt to make students understand the gender concepts, gender related issues and problems, and the way forward for gender equity for a consequent harmonious society. A representative list of such courses, which are integrated in the curricula of various programs of DSU, involves: Media, Gender, and Human Rights Constitution of India and Professional Ethics Indian Culture and Heritage Political Communication Advanced Organizational Behaviour Employee Relations and Labour Laws Media and Cultural Studies Personality Development Human Resource Management Professional and Business Ethics Law for Engineers Media Laws and Ethics Sociology Technical Communication During the design of curricula and syllabi stage itself, emphasis is given to include either a few topics or even a module in the courses, on gender equity, human element, and ethical practice. Further, the summer internships, mandatory internships, and projects in industries expose the students towards gender sensitization. DSU enthusiastically celebrates International Women's Day, through invited talks, debates, and various competitions with the theme of gender equity and women empowerment. The University takes initiative to organize events, debates, quizzes, workshops, seminars, webinars, guest lectures, and student elocution competitions in this regard. These activities aim at creation of gender sensitivity, vitalization to address gender related issues, as well as competence augmentation to reinforce the knowledge set and skills required to address and deliberate on the gender equity concerns. Safety and security of female students, faculty members and staff have been on top of the priorities for university administration, with multiple steps taken including installation of CCTVs on campus. DSU has tie-up with an external professional counsellor, who is available on a need basis. In order to attend to health care needs of women, a female doctor available in the campus. DSU has setup a Women Redressal Cell, that addresses issues of women on the campus. DSU also has established an Anti Sexual Harassment Committee that safeguards women at workplace, in hostels and class-rooms. Further, the following also support the women students and faculty members, like, Personal Counselling Cell, Student Grievances Redressal, Anti Ragging Committee, and so on. Proportional representation of women is ensured in every such cell / committee, drawn from students' body as well as from employees. DSU is an equal-gender opportunity-provider university, in all its academic, administrative and allied activities

awareness amongst females, they become an easy target of harassment and face problems. To strive towards enabling women to achieve equality and equal participation in all spheres of life by securing her due rights and entitlements through suitable policy formulation, legislative measures, effective enforcement of laws, implementation of schemes/policies and devising strategies for solution of specific problems/situations arising out of discrimination and atrocities against women. In coherence with the UGC recommendations, Dayanand Sagar University(DSU) have established a women Redressal Cell to promote a culture of respect and gender equality. The Cell is required to work in the direction of providing help to any female complaining of discrimination, either gender discrimination or otherwise, any kind of abuse, loneliness, peer pressure, groupism, home sickness, insecurity and/or inferiority complex in terms of physical appearance, hostel issues, harassment from room-mates, adjusting and adopting to the new environment, etc. Objectives of Women Redressal Cell A women redressal cell is constituted at the university level with the following objectives: 1. The provision of opportunities and programs for female gender to be financially, mentally and emotionally empowered so as to promote their growth as individuals in their own right 3. To conduct seminar, workshop to impart knowledge of opportunities and tools available and train the women 4. To inculcate entrepreneurial attitude among young girls, at the earliest so that they can be "job givers" rather than "job takers" 5. To make women understand that Empowered and educated women are less likely to fall prey to sexual abuse, workplace harassment, domestic abuse many more 6. To imbibe the idea that child marriage, dowry killings, discrimination, female feticide, etc., and other harmful acts can be stopped by women empowerment. Functions of Women Redressal Cell 1. Promote a healthy working environment for all our female staff, students and faculty. 2. Work towards building a gender-sensitized environment at our university. 3. Organize workshops and awareness programmes at regular intervals towards building a gender-neutral workplace. 4. Celebrating women's day and other important events. 5. Dissemination of information pertaining to women related issues. 6. To create a formal and informal procedure to resolve the matters pertaining to academic, personal and work place issues. 7. To do proper documentation related to various events, lectures etc. Roles and responsibilities The members are to ensure that no act or incident as mentioned hereinabove, and reported is ignored. The members must go to the roots of the harassments faced by students and sort out the matter harmoniously. 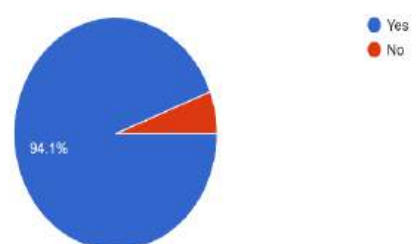
How satisfied are you with the overall event?

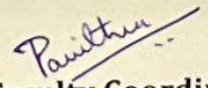
